



Range Rules & Safety Regulations

Last Updated: 13 January 2026

By entering our premises you agree to the underlying rules and the accompanying waiver, release of liability, and indemnity.

1. Access and General Conduct

- This premises is under 24-hour video surveillance.
- We reserve the right to deny access to any person for any reason.
- You may be held responsible for any damage or breakages caused by you or members of your party on this premises.
- Parking on this premises is at your own risk.
- No pets are allowed on the premises.
- Indoor smoking is prohibited.
- All shooters & spectators must sign the Range Register and complete an indemnity form before entering the range.
- All persons on the range must wear approved eye and ear protection at all times.
- Appropriate attire is required on the range: closed-toe shoes must be worn; low-cut tops and open collars are discouraged due to hot brass hazards.
- A maximum of 2 persons (1 shooter, 1 bystander) are allowed per shooting lane at any time.
- All accidents, injuries, or near-misses must be reported to a Range Officer immediately.
- No food or drink is permitted on the range.
- No persons under the influence of alcohol or intoxicating substances are permitted on the range.
- Persons under 21 years of age may only access the range under the direct supervision of a responsible adult.

2. Firearm Handling & Safety

- All persons entering these premises must take all reasonable steps to ensure the safety of themselves and others.
- Range Officer commands must be followed immediately and without question.
- Firearms must remain unloaded with magazines removed when not on a shooting lane. Loading may only occur at the firing line.

- While on the firing line, you may not turn around with a loaded firearm.
- Do not touch another person's firearm or equipment without their express permission.
- Never leave a firearm unattended anywhere on the premises.
- All firearms must be cleared and verified safe by the range officer before you leave the range floor.

3. Shooting Procedures

- Minimum shooting distance is 7 meters.
- Rapid fire is not permitted.
- Drawing from a holster is only permitted with prior Range Officer approval.
- Only shoot at designated targets - shooting at the target frames, carriers, walls, ceiling, or floor is strictly prohibited.
- Only paper or cardboard targets approved by the range may be used.

4. Firearm & Ammunition Restrictions

- No unlicensed firearms or ammunition are allowed on this range.
- No armor-piercing, incendiary, or tracer ammunition is permitted.
- Please check with the Range Officer before using any firearm other than a handgun on the range

5. Cease Fire and Malfunctions

- When "Cease Fire" is called, immediately stop shooting, unload your firearm, place it on the bench with the action open, and step back from the firing line.
- In the event of a malfunction, keep the firearm pointed downrange and raise your non-dominant hand to signal the Range Officer for assistance.
